The Bloomers! Schoolyard Curriculum is inquiry-based, therefore all answers the children give are valid. The answers here are only meant as examples to get the discussion started.

“Rain, Rain Go Away”

What is the special day that the Bloomers! are going to celebrate?

Answer: Earth Day

Why are Rosey & Lilly sad?

Answer: Because it's raining and they don't think they can go outside. (Rosey doesn't want to get her petals wet, Lilly doesn't want the rain to ruin the crowns she made for Earth Day.)

Which of the Bloomers! says he likes to play in the rain?

Answer: Pete Moss

Why is it good when it rains?

Answer: Because plants and flowers need water to live and grow.

What happens if plants and flowers don't get enough water?

Answer: They wilt, and their leaves turn brown.
